**Directions:** Head NORTH on MAIN ST. /HW 91; Turn RIGHT on 400 North.

Proceed EAST through the canyon to the “T” in Garden City.

FOR ACCOMODATIONS & RACE START/FINISH & SAME-DAY

Registration - Turn RIGHT in center of Garden City and precede SOUTH apx 3.5 miles to Blue Water Resort.

***Please be respectful and observe Blue Water Resort rules, especially regarding Pets. All Pets must be on-leash and under control of owner. No free-roaming in Blue Water, especially Start/Finish Line! Failure to control pets will result in riders disqualification from race.***

1. Race organizers reserve the right to combine or alter the categories and/or awards.
2. Results will be posted at the end of each race location at Blue Water Resort, 2126 S. Bear Lake Blvd., Garden City, UT and on the race web site at [www.loganraceclub.org](http://www.loganraceclub.org) and the UCA Web Site

## **Rider Conduct**

1. All participants, coaches, fans and support personnel of the Bear Lake Classic must be aware that the races take place on public roads, most of which are not closed to traffic, and that they will be exposed to other hazards common to urban and rural settings. All parties must use caution at all times. Racers must wear helmets at all times, including warm-ups and cool downs.
2. Utah is the second driest state in the U.S. The Bear Lake Classic events are physically demanding. Come prepared for high temperatures. Participants in Bear Lake Classic events have waived and released the Bear Lake Classic, its promoters, sponsors, volunteers, race officials, and other personnel associated with the race from liability for personal injury, property damage or other claims which might arise due to the participants' taking part in the race.
3. **Centerline rule will be enforced. Centerline violations lead to dead racers. If you cannot abide by this rule, don't bother sending in your registration.**
4. Wheel support will be provided for as many race categories as possible. Priority will be given to Elite Men and Women, descending to Junior and Citizen racers. Sweep vehicle will be available for stranded racers, but be prepared to be self sufficient.
5. **Please show respect for those that you are racing with and the citizens of the Bear Lake Area. Restrooms are provided at each race venue. Bushes and trees are not considered restrooms.**
6. Feeding is allowed in designated Feed Zones only.

## **Road Race Information:**

**Wheel Vehicles** will be provided for Men's Pro 1,2 and Women 1,2,3 and other categories as available. Volunteers for driving wheel vehicles are welcome!

**Sag Wagon** will be provided for stranded riders at the end of the races and rides only. Racers picked up by the sag wagon are considered as DNF.

**Personal Support Vehicles** are discouraged. Support personnel for feed zones should park in designated parking areas only. Support personnel vehicles are responsible for their own directions and navigation.

Awards for General Classification will be presented at the Blue Water Resort immediately following the finalization of "top 4-10" results (depending upon # of entries) in each category.

**Course Description:** 3.4 mile uphill climb from Garden City, *Inn at Bear Lake* (across street from Chevron Station and Cemetery) to the Rocky Point look out pull-off. Racers will start on 30-second intervals and will climb right hand side of road, single file. Racers will yield to traffic for return back to The Inn at the Lake (Start location) – traffic guards will assist road crossing on return; however, use EXTREME caution when crossing the road for return to start point.

**Awards:** Friday evening, following the ITT at The Inn at Bear Lake.

**LEFT SIDE**

**Course Description:** 51-mile flat loop with some rolling hills on east shore, followed by a FLAT and FAST finish. For those racing two (2) laps, there will be a Feed Zone at Blue Water – for your 2<sup>nd</sup> lap. There is NO FEED ZONE for the first lap; come prepared to ride the 51-mile race.

**Course Directions:** From the Blue Water Resort Driveway, turn right and proceed on highway (NO Bike Path) in west/North direction. Apx 15.8 miles @ Bear Cave Drive-In/North Beach Access, turn right proceeding east. After passing through North Beach and just past the Hot Springs, at the top of hill (apx. 22.7 miles), the “paved” road turns to the right and heads south down the back side of Bear Lake – please yield to possible traffic coming from the north as you make the right-hand turn. As you head down south down the back side of B.L., please be cautious at the three (3) cattle guards (Apx. Mile – 28, 30 & 42.5). Apx. 45 miles, at Lake Town be cautious of the sharp right-turn (stay on your side of the yellow/white line(s)) – proceed west, back towards Blue Water. Apx. 100 meters before reaching Blue Water, turn left onto Golf Course Road (Closed Road) for the final “flat” finish

# Xzude Bear Lake Classic: USCF Team Time Trial

**Sunday, May 16, 2010**

**Start Times:** First team will go off at: **8:45 AM**  
Teams will depart in **2-minute intervals**. Don't miss your start!

**Specifics:** The Team Time Trial is a non-UCA scored event. Intended to be a fun and team building experience – enjoy! The TTT is a “5-man” race – all 5 must start; only 3 are required to finish. All scoring will be on the 3<sup>rd</sup> racer to cross the finish line. Mixed groups are allowed; however, for men, all racers must race in the highest category within the team (i.e. if Cat 3 team has one Cat 1 racer – the entire team will register as a Cat 1 team.
